Exhibition Dates: March 6 - April 1, 2020

Description

Shoreline City Hall and Student Art Spaces are excited to announce an exhibition showcasing young artists. Artists ages 13-24 in Washington may apply to have their artwork featured in the 1 month-long exhibition, which will be on view at Shoreline City Hall from March 6 to April 1.

Student Art Spaces invites underrepresented local artists to explore and interpret the theme, which is “Coming Home.” What do you perceive ‘home’ as, and what does home mean to you? It is an exciting opportunity to display work in a public and professional space, and will showcase a range of artistic media highlighting some of the best talent of the next generation of artists and craftspeople.

Jurors

Once the application deadline has closed, jurors from Student Art Spaces will review entries and select artists to participate in the exhibition. Artists will be informed by February 12 as to whether or not they have been selected.

Eligibility

Eligibility is limited to individuals residing in Washington state. Artists may be at any level in their artistic careers, but must be between the ages of 13-24 on the date the show opens to the public on March 6, 2020. Each artist may submit up to three artworks. Each piece that is submitted with the intention of being shown in the exhibition must be fully original (made by you); however, collaboration between multiple artists is permitted. We welcome all 2D, 3D, and video work.

Limitations & Agreement

Student Art Spaces reserves the right to reject, upon arrival, any work that differs significantly in appearance, quality, and craftsmanship from the artist's proposal. All accepted artwork must remain on view for the duration of the exhibition at the Shoreline City Hall. Student Art Spaces shall have the right to photograph works in the exhibition and use images of all included works for promotional purposes and in future publications.
